## WHY DID YOU MOVE KIDS CAMP FROM THE DAY TO THE EVENING?

Great question! We moved KIDS CAMP to begin at 6:30PM to reach more people in our community and grow our adult volunteer base who would otherwise be at work. Join us in prayer that an evening KIDS CAMP would provide us with new opportunities to introduce the HOPE of Christ with our community.

# WHAT WILL KIDS BE DOING?

Your kids are in for an unforgettable week where they will have a blast with their friends through energetic stage experiences, compete in games, and connect in small groups. We group kids in the same 'pod' or small group, with the same leader, so they can quickly make friends!

Along with having the MOST FUN EVER, kids will discover four different ways we can FOCUS on God: Hear, Talk, Pray, Live. KIDS CAMP is a high-energy, fun environment designed to give kids an amazing week of memories and growing in faith!

# I'VE HEARD THAT THURSDAY IS FAMILY NIGHT. CAN YOU TELL ME ABOUT THAT?

Kids are dropped off Monday through Wednesday, but THURSDAY is an event for families to attend together. There will be food trucks, a family show in the Worship Center, and fun afterwards. The show will start at 6:30. \*More details on Food Trucks coming soon ... but plan for 5PM. Your whole family is welcome to attend, not just your kids who were registered for camp. Dessert will be free, dinner is on you.

#### CAN I VOLUNTEER?

Yes! We want to keep your kids safe so Woodside policy is that all volunteers must be members of Woodside who have attended for at least 6 months and have completed our Child Protection Program (CPP) training which includes a background check. Go to our website > 'Get Involved' > Serve

# CAN MY TEEN SERVE WITH ME?

Teenage volunteers must have completed 6th grade, members of Woodside (or in the process of pursuing membership), and must also complete the CPP program through student ministry's leadership program to be eligible to serve. Student Ministry will hold a Membership Class called 'Belong for Students' on Sunday May 2nd at 11:30am. Contact a Student Ministry Director to reserve your spot.

## IF I SERVE AT CAMP, WHAT DO I DO WITH MY INFANT OR TODDLER?

There will be care for leaders' kids who are birth through 2 years old (or 3 and not yet fully potty-trained)

#### CAN I INVITE A FRIEND?

Yes! KIDS CAMP is more fun with friends! This is an event not just for Woodside but for our community! It's best if kids are grouped with friends who are the same age/grade, but some exceptions can be made depending on the age difference between the friends.

#### WILL FOOD OR SNACKS BE SERVED?

Because our KIDS CAMP is two hours, there will be no food or snacks during our programming. We are planning to have food trucks on Thursday evening for our Family event. (Food trucks on Thursday night will be available for your family to purchase dinner.)

# WILL MASKS BE REQUIRED?

Our current Woodside Kids policy allows kids to choose whether to wear a mask while in the kids environments. Elementary leaders are required to wear a mask on Sunday mornings at this time. We will monitor safety regulations and Woodside Bible Church weekend policies in the weeks to come and communicate any potential changes to those who register.

#### WHAT IF MY CHILD NEEDS MEDICATION?

If your child will require medication during camp, you must bring your child's medications to the check-in table in the original packaging and in a clearly marked plastic zipper bag the first evening of camp. Small Group Leaders may not accept medication, nor may your child carry it with them unless you have specifically made arrangements with the registration staff.

# CAN YOU TELL ME ABOUT THE THEME NIGHTS? AND WHAT SHOULD MY KID WEAR?

Yes! This year we're adding theme nights. Wardrobe FYI, as you pick up your child on Monday, you will receive their KIDS CAMP shirt.
