 - Serving as their resourcing Ministry leader and coach, which involves monthly one-on-ones and suggested goal setting through EDGE.
- > Serves as a HUB Ministry team member to resource and support their assigned Campus Ministry Directors and act as their liaison to ensure open and consistent communication lines.

- > Midweek Ministry: Oversee, recruit, and lead midweek programming (Midtown)
- > Upward Basketball: Oversee, support volunteer leaders, ensure CPP is followed
- > Manage WK Staff: Oversee, train, lead multiple WK staff members
