- Grows the Student Ministries through teaching the gospel, outreach events, and helping outsiders connect with our church
- Plans and structures main events for students ideally one per semester during school and one per month during summer (e.g., student lock-in, trips to Cedar point, pumpkin-carving contests, etc.)
- Develops goals, objectives, and reports progress through EDGE development system under the leadership of the Campus Pastor
- Oversees all areas of weekend ministry including curriculum, program, resources, volunteers, and coordinators
- > Hosts Leadership Team meetings and training for Students Ministries volunteers
- > Coordinates volunteer appreciation as needed
- > Follows Child Protection Program procedures and works with the Child Protection Program team
- > Attends weekly campus staff meetings
- > Meets regularly with Student Ministries staff
- Oversees the campus budget for Student Ministries
