- Balances and manages multifaceted aspects of ministry responsibilities; relational, program and administrative
- Leads on stage 40 weeks in a calendar year. Nine weeks per calendar year should be leading off stage, or in a different role on stage, where needed

HUB Team Member:

- Direct report to Campus Pastor with a dotted line to the Central Worship Pastor. Participates in any meetings specific to the Hub Ministry role
 - Assists the Central Worship Pastor by observing and evaluating Ministry DNA and collaborating and executing alongside the Central Worship Pastor and HUB Ministry team on any other tasks that would support the growth and health of the ministry
- Collaborates with the HUB Ministry team by providing leadership, encouragement, and support to the determined Campus Directors within their HUB. Serves as their resourcing Ministry leader and coach, which involves monthly one-on-ones and suggested goal setting through EDGE
- Serves as a HUB Ministry team member to resource and support their assigned Campus Ministry Directors and acts as their liaison to ensure open and consistent communication lines
