TEN COMMANDMENTS (Exodus 19-20)

Week 1

Brite Idea: God tells us how life works best.

He Question: Why is God the One who makes the rules?

God is our Creator and King. He rules the world.
Since He created everything, He knows how
life works best. God's rules can help us better
understand who He is.

We Question: How do we know what God wants us to do?

God has given us the Bible to show us who He is and how He wants us to live. We can learn more by reading His Word.

THE TWELVE SPIES (Numbers 13-14)

Week 2

Brite Idea: God can be trusted.

He Question: Why can God be trusted?

God is faithful and completely trustworthy. We may not always understand God's ways, but because He is completely good, everything He does is right and good. We Question: What does it mean to trust God?

We believe God loves us and knows what's best. We depend on Him and trust we can seek to live life His way because we know He is in control.

THE WALLS OF JERICHO (Joshua 1:1-3; 5:13-6:27)

Week 3

Brite Idea: God leads His people.

He Question: What kind of leader is God?

God is a wise leader who always does what is best and knows what is best because He is sovereign over all and loves His people deeply. He fights for His people and has a perfect plan. **We Question:** How do we follow God when it doesn't make sense?

We can trust that God is a good leader even if we don't understand why His way is best for us. He will always lead us to do what is best for His plan.

SAMSON (Judges 13-16)

Week 4

Brite Idea: God is faithful even when we are not.

He Question: Can anything change God's

faithfulness to His people?

God keeps His promises, no matter what. Because He loves His people so much, He does allow consequences for sin.

We Question: What can we do when we are not faithful to God?

When we mess up we can choose to either continue to do things our own way or we can choose to ask God for forgiveness and turn back to Him.
