

## Qualifications

- Woodside Bible Preschool is licensed by the State of Michigan. Our teachers meet the educational qualifications as established by the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.
- All employees and unsupervised volunteers must undergo a criminal history background check, including submission of FBI fingerprints and completion of Woodside Bible Church Child Protection Program.
- Our staff attends conferences, seminars, and workshops and complete continuing education requirements to give them the opportunity to stay current with early childhood educational changes.



## Philosophy

## Age Group

We invite children between the ages of 2 and five to enter Preschool, meeting the following age requirements:

- TK (Young 5s) - a child must turn 5 years old by Dec. 31 of the current school year
- 4s - a child must turn 4 years old by Sept. 15 of the current school year
- 3s - a child must turn 3 years old by Sept. 15 of the current school year
- 2s Parent/Child - a child must be turn 2 years old by Sept. 15 of the current school year

## Our Program

Attending Woodside Bible Preschool affords children the opportunity for social and emotional growth, along with the skills necessary for a smooth transition into kindergarten.

## Registration & Tuition

Tuition:

\*TK (Young 5s) : \$2600 a year

\*4s : \$2035 a year

\*3s: \$1515 a year

\*A \$75 non-refundable registration fee is required for the 3s, 4s, and TK (Young 5s) programs

Payment Options:

You may choose to pay by the month, at \$169 per month for 3s, \$227 per month for 4s , & \$289 for TK (Young 5s).

Payment is due on the first of the month.

Tuition:

\*2s Parent/Child: \$380 a year

\*A \$25 non-refundable registration fee is required for the 2s Parent/Child program

A multiple child discount is available for families with more than one child enrolled in the same school year.

Discounts are given to Woodside Bible Church part-time and full-time staff.
