



LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

Remember that Life Groups are a place where we practice what is preached. We discuss the Bible for transformation, not just information.



Icebreaker: If you could visit any time and place, when and where would you chose to spend time? What is appealing about that time/place to you?



PRAY:

Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.



READ:

Ask a group member to read **Luke 6:17-26** out loud.



DISCUSS:

This week's passages shows us what life in God's kingdom looks like. How does God's kingdom help us re-prioritize our lives?



IDENTITY:

Where am you still defining "blessed" by the world's standards instead of Jesus'? What is true about who you are in Christ, even when your circumstances don't reflect it?

WORSHIP



Where are you most tempted to build your life around comfort, success, or approval, and how might that be shaping what you truly worship?

COMMUNITY

In what ways might your current Life Group rhythms or relationships overlook people who are struggling? What would it look like to move toward them as a community instead?

MISSION

When we share the gospel with others we're not just inviting people into a future in heaven, we're also inviting them into a new way of living in the kingdom of God here and now. How does that change the way we invite others into faith?



GROUP ENGAGE:

Jesus announces a kingdom where the overlooked, hurting, and rejected are called blessed. As His people, we are invited to both live in that kingdom and invite others into it.

Have each person in your Life Group identify one individual who is struggling, overlooked, or far from God's kingdom and share their name with the group. Pray for them together and take one step each week to move toward them. As a group, look for an opportunity to invite them into community or a space where they can experience the kingdom of God. Consider hosting a spring picnic, party, or gathering for people to see your group display the kingdom of God.

WE ARE FAMILY:

How can you hold each other accountable to respond to God this week?

Share prayer requests (either as a group, or as partners/ smaller groups)

VALUE SPOTLIGHT:

BEAUTY | That which reflects the glory of God.

When we orient our lives around God's kingdom, it shows the glory of God to the world.

Luke 6:27-36

Big Idea: Live like Jesus by loving everyone
Key Question: How do we love like Jesus?

- Love without expectations (vv. 27-36)
- Love without exception (vv. 27-36)
- Love with actions (vv. 27-36)

APRIL 26

Luke 6:36-42

Big Idea: Live like Jesus by extending mercy before judgement
Key Question: How do we live a life marked by mercy?

- Mirror God's immeasurable compassion (vv. 26-38)
- Mind your heart before mending another's (vv. 39-42)

MAY 3

Luke 6:43-49

Big Idea: Live Like Jesus by trusting and obeying Him
Key Question: What produces a life that lasts?

- Root your heart in Christ (vv. 43-45)
- Build your life on His Word (vv. 46-49)
