



LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

Remember that Life Groups are a place where we practice what is preached. We discuss the Bible for transformation, not just information.



Icebreaker: What is something you've built or worked hard on that you were proud of, and what made it strong enough to last?



PRAY:

Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.



READ:

Ask a group member to read **Luke 6:43-49** out loud.



DISCUSS:

This week's passage contrasts shallow foundations with a life built on the words of Jesus. Where do you most often feel the difference between stability and shakiness in your everyday life?



IDENTITY:

Jesus teaches that what comes out of us reveals what is rooted within us. What do your words, reactions, and habits reveal about what you truly believe about yourself and God right now?

WORSHIP



Jesus is worthy not just of admiration, but obedience (v. 46). What area of your life is God inviting you to trust Him more deeply and put His words into practice?

COMMUNITY

A strong foundation is often built with others around us. How can this group help one another move from simply hearing Jesus' words to actually living them out?

MISSION

Many people around us are trying to build life on shaky foundations. How could God use your story, words, or actions this week to point someone toward the solid foundation of Christ?



GROUP ENGAGE:

Jesus announces a kingdom where the overlooked, hurting, and rejected are called blessed. As His people, we are invited to both live in that kingdom and invite others into it.

Have each person in your Life Group identify one individual who is struggling, overlooked, or far from God's kingdom and share their name with the group. Pray for them together and take one step each week to move toward them. As a group, look for an opportunity to invite them into community or a space where they can experience the kingdom of God. Consider hosting a spring picnic, party, or gathering for people to see your group display the kingdom of God.

WE ARE FAMILY:

How can you hold each other accountable to respond to God this week?

Share prayer requests (either as a group, or as partners/smaller groups)

VALUE SPOTLIGHT:

GOODNESS | That which communicates the reality of God.

When we live lives of obedience, we not only worship God, but also show the world the truth about who God is.

Big Idea: Live like Jesus by loving everyone
Key Question: How do we love like Jesus?

- Love without expectations (vv. 27-36)
- Love without exception (vv. 27-36)
- Love with actions (vv. 27-36)

APRIL 26

Luke 6:36-42

Big Idea: Live like Jesus by extending mercy before judgement
Key Question: How do we live a life marked by mercy?

- Mirror God's immeasurable compassion (vv. 26-38)
- Mind your heart before mending another's (vv. 39-42)

MAY 3

Luke 6:43-49

Big Idea: Live Like Jesus by trusting and obeying Him
Key Question: What produces a life that lasts?

- Root your heart in Christ (vv. 43-45)
- Build your life on His Word (vv. 46-49)
